

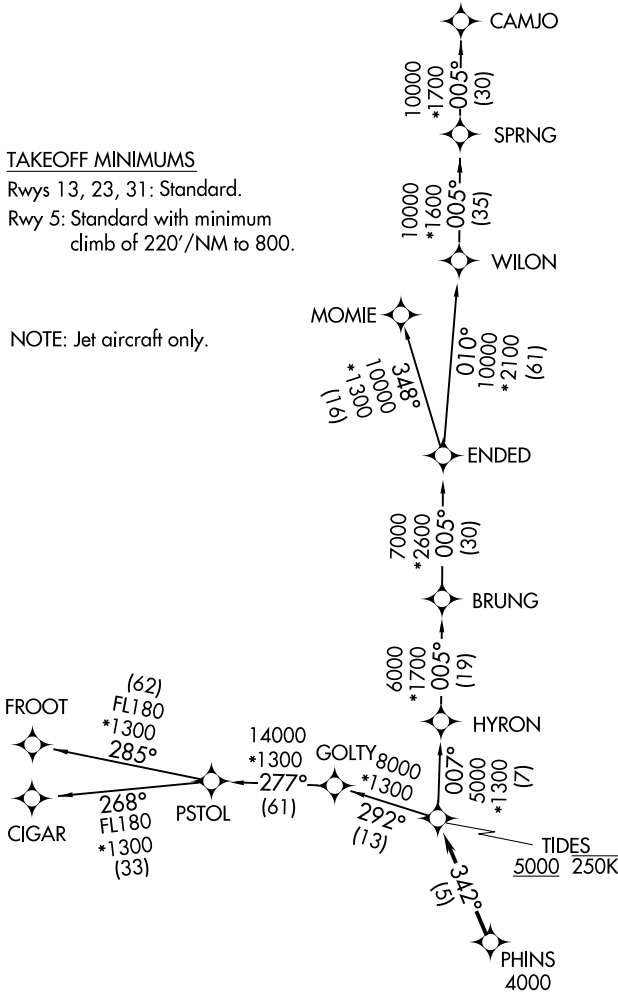

DEPARTURE ROUTE DESCRIPTION

TAKEOFF RUNWAY 5: Climb on heading 050° or as assigned by ATC, for  
RADAR vectors to PHINS, thence. . . .

TAKEOFF RUNWAY 13: Climb on heading 140° or as assigned by ATC, for  
RADAR vectors to PHINS, thence. . . .

TAKEOFF RUNWAY 23: Climb on heading 230° or as assigned by ATC, for  
RADAR vectors to PHINS, thence. . . .

TAKEOFF RUNWAY 31: Climb on heading 320° or as assigned by ATC, for  
RADAR vectors to PHINS, thence. . . .

. . . .on track 342° to cross TIDES at or above 5000 and at or below 250K.  
Maintain ATC assigned altitude, expect clearance to filed altitude within 10  
minutes after departure.
