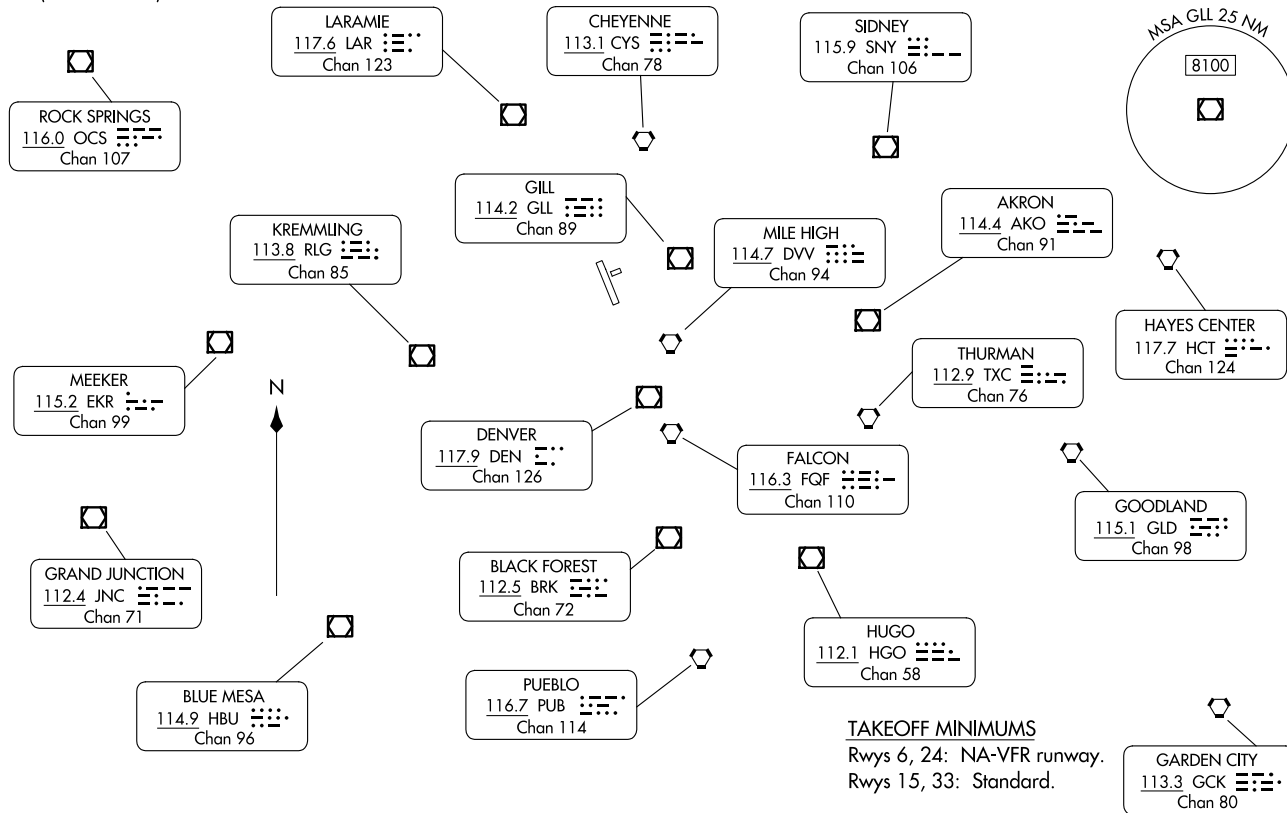

DEPARTURE ROUTE DESCRIPTION

TAKEOFF RUNWAY 15: Climb to assigned altitude and heading between 180° CCW 350° from end of runway, thence. . . .

TAKEOFF RUNWAY 33: Climbing right turn to assigned altitude and heading between 350° CW 150° from DER, thence. . . .

. . . .RADAR vectors to assigned route. Expect filed altitude 10 minutes after departure.

LOST COMMUNICATIONS: If no transmissions are received within one minute after departure, maintain assigned heading until 7000, then climb to filed altitude direct to DEN VOR/DME, then on assigned route. If filed altitude is above 10000, cross DEN VOR/DME at or above 11000.
